October's Recommendation by Chris Thomson "The Imperfect Disciple" by Jared C. Wilson



Too many discipleship books are written for clean, perfect people who know all the right Sunday school answers.

"The Imperfect Disciple" is for the rest of us—people who mess up, who are weary, and wondering if it's safe to say what they're really thinking. Let's face it...we are messy, life is messy, and we can get lost in the tension between self-condemnation and God's amazing grace.

With incisive wit, warm humor, and moving stories, Jared Wilson shows readers how the gospel works in them and in their lives when:

- they can't get their act together
- they think God is giving them the silent treatment
- they think church would be better without all the people
- they're not happy with the person in the mirror
- and much more

Wilson frees readers from the self-doubt and even the misplaced self-confidence they may feel as they walk with Jesus down the often difficult road of life. The result is a faith that weathers storms, lifts burdens, and goes forth to make more imperfect disciples.

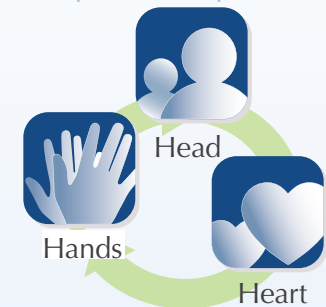
