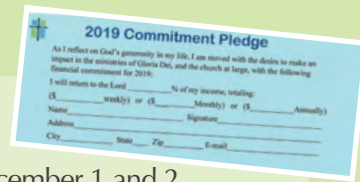


2019 Commitment Pledges

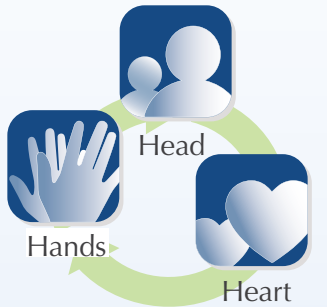
