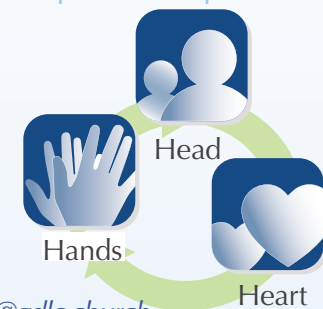

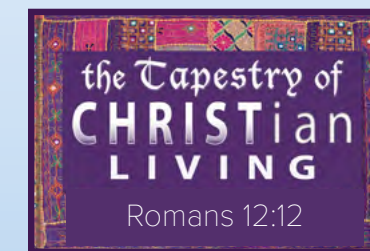

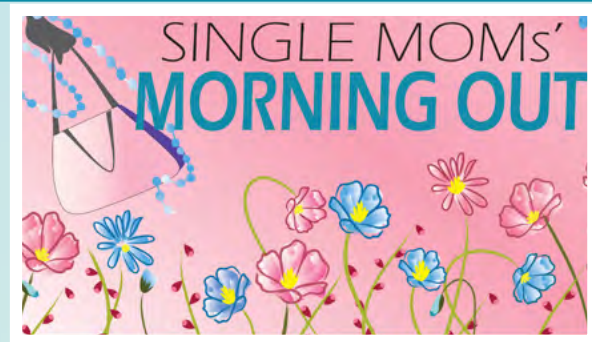

Book Recommendation

March's book of the month recommendation, "Discipled by Jesus" by Robert Gelinas, is from Tim Kightlinger, Director of Youth Ministry.

One of the main teachings of "Discipled by Jesus" is that we need a reformation in our understanding of discipleship. Gelinas makes this case, suggesting that our definition is incomplete. Gelinas issues a call for us to connect – in real-time – with the risen Christ, who is alive and inviting us to enroll in his school of ongoing discipleship. He also states that we are transformed when we are truly open to Christ's teaching. As Gelinas says, "the call of the shepherd comes with a new identity." Even though Jesus is resurrected, he hasn't stopped teaching. Throughout the Bible, the experiences of the Apostles demonstrate what life should be like for us. The Holy Spirit is a gift of the Father so we can know him better and see more clearly.
