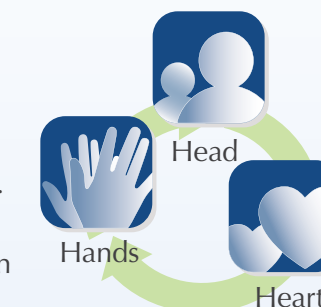

Along with the Apostles Creed we also hold to the Nicene Creed and the Athanasian Creed as statements to our shared beliefs. What is remarkable is that throughout Scripture we see that creeds are a very important device that gives a unity of belief and a One Voice approach to the faith that is held by the community. 1 Corinthians 15:1-4 is known to be one of the early churches' statements of faith from around the years 31-35 AD and the Apostles Creed is dated around 370-390 AD. Needless to say we follow in a long line of Christians who have shared with One Voice the things that we are One in Belief on.
