We have returned. We had a wonderful mission trip to Tegucigalpa, Honduras. We worshiped in a Honduran church. We had powerful devotions twice a day. We made many new friendships with our Honduran brothers and sisters. We had the honor of presenting your gifts and demonstrating the love of Jesus.

We saw more than 2,400 people in four days during our work in the clinic. We saw more than 200 people come to faith as we shared the message of Salvation by grace through faith in Jesus Christ. We plan to have a presentation about our trip in middle July.

Children:

(Infant to age 4):

Nursery: Located on the lower level, the nursery is staffed during all worship services for children ages 3 and under at no cost to the parent. The nursery can be accessed through the door on the southwest side of the Connection Center.

Communion:

The Lord's Supper or Communion is a Biblical event, given by Jesus for the strengthening of our faith and the forgiveness of our sins (Matthew 26). God's Word is very clear that when we receive the bread and wine of the Lord's Supper we also literally/physically receive the actual body and blood of Jesus (1 Corinthians 10:16 and 1 Corinthians 11:23-30). If you are a baptized Christian who trusts in Christ's presence, recognizes your sinfulness, and desires not only to be forgiven of those sins, but also needs strength from Jesus to amend your daily life, then you are welcome to join us! If you do not believe Christ is present, or are unsure of what you believe and want further explanation, then please feel free to speak with one of our Pastors at a convenient time. (We provide both non-alcoholic wine in the center of the tray and gluten-free wafers in containers.)
