Book of the Month Reading

Recommendations:

As part of a larger strategy to encourage our members to bring their own Bibles to worship, we will offer journaling Bibles for purchase. There will be several cover options. Along with the Bibles, we will offer a Scripture Journal which is strictly the book of Luke to coincide with our study of the same. We will encourage our members to work through Luke throughout the year whether they go to the Bible study or not. Both resources will be available for purchase in September.

The amazing men who currently make our Faith Chests have developed a small box for our kitchen tables to place our cell phones in during meals. We also ask families to put devotional materials in or by the box. The idea behind the project will be to encourage families toward “Head-Heart-Hands” discussions when they gather for meals rather than looking at their phones. When families gather for a meal, they can swap cell phones for devotionals and to enjoy family discussions.


