Mission to Mortgage

As you can see from the graphs below, we have made significant strides in reducing our mortgage balance since the beginning of



our Phase 3 "Mortgage to Missions" endeavor in September 2017. Between our refinancing in the spring of 2017 and your generous gifts, we reduced our mortgage balance by \$350,000 in the span of one year, while also reducing our monthly interest payment by \$2,041.

That translates into annualized interest savings of \$24,492, which can now be used for ministry purposes on an ongoing basis.

November's Book Recommendation

The following is November's book recommendation from Steve Kowbel, Director of Worship Ministries.

"The Voice of the Psalms" - Psalms Retold by the Friends of Ecclesia Bible Society Written by Karen Moore and James F. Couch, Jr.

A few years ago as I was attending a continuing education event one of the gifts was "The Voice of the Psalms." While I would hold fast to the trusted translations of scripture (at Gloria Dei we use the English Standard Version), I have found it beneficial in my personal pursuit of God to read through different translations to bump me off of the familiarity of the scriptures that I have read through the years.

"The Voice of the Psalms" pairs the psalms with a devotional thought following the text as well as four reading plans (Advent, Lent, comfort and guidance and praise)

I have found in times when I'm lacking direction of where to land in scripture, this tool has helped give me a good frame work on where to dive back in.

You won't have to be a songwriter to enjoy the songs of the ancients. Also, since we recently studied Psalms this summer, this book will continue the work of the living Word of God in your life. I pray that it brings inspiration and comfort as you continue to pursue and discover God.
