Clean-Water Initiative

Thursday, October 3 at 6:30 p.m. & Sunday, Oct. 6 at 11:45 a.m. The Governing Board would like to invite you to an informational discussion of the renovation of the Family Life Center, the updating of the kitchen, the creation of new storage areas and the expansion of and ADA compliance for our restrooms. The architect has proposed a design for us and has furthermore compiled a budget amounting to \$1,870,000. While this clearly far exceeds what we expected for the renovation, it is nonetheless a project that we are recommending to you at this time. Before we ask you to vote on this at our October 27 Annual Meeting, we want to give you as much information as is possible ahead of time. We want you to hear about the project from Pastor Meyer and other staff members, but we also want to hear how you feel about it as well as get your feedback on the plan, the scope and the budget. There will be two meetings for this purpose, and will be in the Family Life Center.
